Clean Water is Life!

- 884 million people - about 1 in 8, do not have access to clean drinking water.
- 1.5 million children die each year from diarrhea caused by poor water or sanitation.
- Women in rural Africa typically carry 45 lbs of water for up to 4 hours round trip to their village.
- Over 40 million kids suffer from intestinal parasites due to contaminated water.
- Many kids are unable to attend school due to having to carry water for the family.

You can't do everything...but you **CAN** do something!

Real Life Family Center's "Revolution Challenge Project" is aimed at raising awareness and resources to help meet the needs for clean water and sanitation for a Maasai tribal village in Kenya, East Africa. Americans spend far more on pet supplies each year than we do on helping out the world's poorest individuals simply have access to clean drinking water. Close access to clean water is a fundamental key to helping break the cycle of poverty in many of these villages. Water is tied to health, of course, but also to education (children spending hours a day carrying water) and employment (traveling for water rather than earning family income).

While we cannot do everything, we can each do something. Each well we drill, each dose of anti viral medication we give out helps begin to bring about health and break the vicious cycle of poverty.

If we all just pitch in what we can, we together, can make an impact and save a life.
